God Wants You Well

Scripture tells us that it's God's will for you to be healed.

The power of God is available to heal all who need healing. He has the power to heal every one of us. My prayer is that this booklet will show you, through the scriptures, that it is God's will for you to be well. I trust in the power of God's word and I believe that, as you sit and read His word, your level of faith and trust in God will begin to grow.

Romans 10:17 says,

*So faith comes from hearing,
that is, hearing the Good News
about Christ. (NLT)*

A lot of people have asked me, "Pastor Jo, would you pray that I have more faith?" I have to tell those people, "No, I can't do that. I can pray for you to be healed. I can pray for you to have a financial breakthrough. I can pray for reconciliation – but I can't pray for you to have more faith because it comes from hearing God's word." The only way

you're going to get more faith is by hearing the word of God. The more you hear the word, the more you read it, the more you memorize it, the more faith you're going to have.

Keep in mind what Paul told the Thessalonians in **I Thessalonians 2:13**. He wrote,

Therefore, we never stop thanking God that when you received his message from us, you didn't think of our words as mere human ideas. You accepted what we said as the very word of God—which, of course, it is. And this word continues to work in you who believe. (NLT)

If you would take this word as a word from Paul, the human being, it won't work for you. If you take this word as a word from Pastor Jo, the human being, it won't work for you. If you take this word as a word from God, delivered through his servants, then it will work for you. Take scripture as if it's God Himself talking to you – because it is.

When you hear God's word being preached on a Sunday, it's Him talking to you. When you read the Bible, it's Him talking to you. We read in **I Peter 4:11**,

Do you have the gift of speaking? Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. Then everything you do will bring glory to God through Jesus Christ. All glory and power to him forever and ever! Amen.

God has given me the gift, and anointed me to speak and to teach. I must teach what He gives me to teach. I never teach anything that I sat down and came up with all by myself, believe me. I'm not that smart! But the Holy Spirit knows all things, and the Bible says the Holy Spirit will teach us all things if we're willing to listen. His spirit guides us through His scripture, to understand how it applies to our lives today. And in His scripture we find the keys to overcome our weaknesses, increase our faith, and receive our healing.

How God Heals

During His time on Earth, Jesus used many ways to heal the sick and the afflicted. One of the ways that He used was to lay hands on the sick. Another way to be healed is by the simple hearing of the word of God.

It makes sense. After all, people become Christians by hearing the word; they get healed by hearing the word. You may have even personally witnessed healings and miracles, as the spirit of God manifested himself through the gifts of the

Spirit. We can't predict or dictate when and how God is going to move spectacularly through the gifts of the Spirit. However, we do know that God's words always work. We don't always have to wait for a miraculous moving. All we have to do is to hear the word and believe the word and act on the word.

You don't have to *feel* healed to *be* healed. Sometimes God heals us in ways or at times that we didn't expect or don't understand. All you have to do is have faith.

In fact, if you don't believe you're *already* healed, your healing won't manifest.

When you were born again, you didn't necessarily feel holy and forgiven. We still sin. We still make mistakes. Yet God says that, by the wounds of Christ, we are healed. In his eyes, we're perfect! Spotless, sinless, and ready to enter into eternity with God – even if we don't feel that way. It's the same with our physical healing. God has already blessed us with the Holy Spirit, who can work miracles in our minds and bodies. Before we can be healed, we must believe that God can and will heal us!

My husband David told me one night that his eye began to hurt him really bad. He had recently undergone eye surgery. It was hurting him so bad he thought he was going to have to get up and leave in the middle of the service. All of a sudden he thought to himself, "*I don't have to put up with*

this!” As a born-again child of God, you don’t have to put up with anything the Devil throws your way.

David said the moment he thought this, the pain stopped – even before he prayed.

He believed it in his heart that he didn’t have to accept the pain and received his healing by hearing the word. He accepted it in his heart and received his healing right then and there. I didn’t even know it was happening.

The word of God is anointed, and God’s word is the same whether you or I feel its anointing or not. People are so hung up on what they feel they miss out on so much. You must not let your feelings dictate what God is capable of giving to you. God is God. He can do anything.

God himself said that you cannot trust your feelings, in **Jeremiah 17:9**.

The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?

Your heart is deceitful, and will try to convince you that you aren’t healed – or even that you

aren’t saved. But you know that’s a lie! So why would you listen to your heart about anything else, when you can listen to the words of God?

Proverbs 4:20-22 says,

My son, pay attention to what I say; turn your ear to my words. Do not let them out of your sight; keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to one’s whole body.

Scripture says over and over that life and health are found in God’s words. In **Matthew 10:1**, we read,

Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness.

That word should convince you if nothing else can that it is God’s will for you to be well.

Remember: Satan is the author of all sickness and disease. God didn’t bring any of it. God brings

healing and redemption. He *wants* you to be well!
He tells you so in **III John 1:2**:

*Dear friend, I pray that you may
enjoy good health and that all may
go well with you, even as your soul
is getting along well.*

God took my sickness and bore my pain so I wouldn't have to. He suffered on the cross to give me life eternal.

Body, Spirit and Soul

When I say that “God Wants You Well,” I’m talking about more than just your physical body. God wants *all of you* well – that includes your body, your soul and your spirit. Your spirit and soul are not secondary parts of you. In fact, your spirit is the most important of all. God wants all of you well. If you expect healing in your body, you better anticipate healing in your spirit, first.

We humans are three-part beings according to **I Thessalonians 5:23**.

*May God himself, the God of peace,
sanctify you through and through.
May your whole spirit, soul and body
be kept blameless at the coming of our
Lord Jesus Christ.*

You are a spirit, a body and a soul and your soul is what the Bible calls the mental and emotional part of you – your mind, your thoughts, your reasoning, your will. It’s your emotions. That’s what your soulish part is.

When you got born again, you became a brand new species of being. Your spirit became totally new according to **II Corinthians 5:17**.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

You know a lot of people think it takes a lot of faith to be healed – but it doesn't take any more than it did to accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior. That was how your spirit got saved. It's also how the mind and body receive healing: By just believing. You heard the word, you believed it and you accepted Him as your Lord and Savior. Now, you need to accept Him as your healer, too. It was a full package. You got everything. When you received Christ as your savior, you got His healing power, too. But your soulish part, your mind, did not get born again.

Therefore, it has to be renewed to God's way of thinking in order for you to experience His promises! One of these promises is how God wants you well and how he has made provision for your healing.

But you first must believe that He wants you well. This is where “mind over matter” comes in. He says, “By his stripes ye were healed” – but first you're going to have to believe it.

Do you believe that God wants you well? If you're still not convinced, I think I can prove it to you that God wants you well. He told you so on the cross.

Jesus Already Won the Victory

I Peter 2:24 says,

He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed. (NLT)

Notice the tense of the verb “healed.” It’s past-tense. I was terrible in English class back in school, but even I know what this means. We are *already* healed! So why do we still have illness, pain and mourning in our lives?

I’m still working on walking closer to the Lord every single day. There are still things that I work on; things that I do or say that I learn later I might not be doing or saying the way God wants. When we say, “I believe God can forgive my sin...” we forget that Jesus already has! So it goes with your health, your finances and your careers. God has promised you good things which you have already received – you’ve got to change your thinking and change the words that you speak to realize them.

When God looks at you, He sees you as a healed person. He does not see you as a sick person.

You’re not *going to be healed* because you’re *already healed*. When God looks at you, He sees you as a healed person. He does not see you as a sick person. God is a right-now God. He’s not just a future God; His promises are for today.

Think of it this way: When you say something like, “I believe that God is able to heal me,” what you’re actually saying is that you don’t know what God’s will is concerning your healing. But He tells you His will in His word is for you to be healed, have good health, receive his blessings, and have life to the full!

You have to *receive* what He has already provided.

All we need to do is reach out and take it. Don’t be one of those people who just sit around and merely say they believe. Faith and action work together. **James 2:27** reminds us,

*In the same way, faith by itself,
if it is not accompanied by
action, is dead.*

Know this well: You are the healed of the Lord. It's the Devil that's trying to steal your health. He is a thief and he's a liar. Satan would like nothing more than to convince you through the symptoms that he has put on your body that you can't be healed. He does that by lying to you, putting pain and suffering in your life and telling you that it's not God's will to heal you.

He'll try to convince you that you don't have enough faith to receive your healing. That's another one of his lies. Some say that God is using your sickness to glorify himself or to teach you something. They believe that sickness glorifies God? Well, if you believe it's God's will that you be sick, then quit going to the doctor. If you believe that God wants you to be sick, so you can learn something or so God can be glorified, yet you go to the doctor for medicine, isn't that contradictory?

Now, there's nothing wrong with going to the doctor. But I always go to the Lord first.

God is the divine healer, and only a word from Him can complete you and bring total healing. The doctors can help you, but you have to believe that God is the ultimate healer.

Only God can fix that which is truly broken. You know that God is the healer. I know God is the healer, but sometimes I might have to take a little something for those symptoms. It's important we know the difference.

Let me ask you a question: Did Jesus ever put sickness on anyone? When people came to Jesus

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No! He healed
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for healing, did He ever turn even one person away? No! He never said, "Well, just suffer a little bit longer. You don't have enough faith to be healed yet." No, He healed those who called upon His name!

God calls sickness and disease Satanic oppression. Satan is the author of sickness. Jesus

is our healer, our deliverer through everything. When you accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you've also accepted Him as your healer. You've got the whole package. In the same way that you said, "Lord, I accept you as my Lord and Savior," we can also say, "I've accepted you now as my healer too. You are my healer." After all, Christ is the only hope we have – not just in the next life, but in this one too.

The Promises of God

It says in **Psalm 30:2**,

*Lord my God, I called to you
for help, and you healed me.*

We also read in **Acts 10:38**,

*How God anointed Jesus of
Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and
with power, who went about doing
good and healing all who were
oppressed by the devil, for God
was with Him.*

We need to understand that God's word is just not mere letters on a page. His word is alive, and filled with His spirit and His power. Jesus says in **John 6:63-64**,

*"The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts
for nothing. The words I have spoken
to you – they are full of the Spirit
and life. Yet there are some of you
who do not believe."*

Let's also remember what **John 1:1-4** tells us about what God's Word truly is:

*In the beginning the Word already existed.
The Word was with God, and the Word was
God. He existed in the beginning with God.
God created everything through him, and
nothing was created except through him.
The Word gave life to everything that
was created, and his life brought light
to everyone. (NLT)*

You see, According to John 1:1, God says He *is his*

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word. The word of God and the person of God are one and the same. All God's power to create and destroy, to bring life, healing and salvation – they're all found in his words.

God's word is His communication with us. In scripture we find His promises to us, the

revelation of Himself to His people. It is a lamp to our feet in a dark and fallen world. Without His Word, we would have no way to even know God or his will. Without the word of God, you wouldn't know what his will is concerning your healing or anything else if you didn't have the Word.

Are you starting to realize just how special that dusty, old Bible of yours is? Good.

I want you to know that God has provided healing and blessing for his children – but you must believe his word. You cannot receive anything He has for you, whether it's a financial blessing or physical healing or some other blessing, without believing His Word.

Keep in mind too what we read earlier in **I Thessalonians 2:13**: If you take His word as a word from Paul, it's not going to work for you. Or if you take this as a word from Pastor Jo, it's not going to work for you either. However, if you will take it as a word from God Himself, I can promise you that it will work for you. Don't pay any attention to the messenger, just focus on the word – that's where the power is. I can promise you that it will work.

Let the Spirit Guide your Hand

Jesus used many methods of administering healing, and one of those ways was the laying on of hands. If you have faith in your heart and the Lord calls you to lay hands on someone or something in prayer, you do it. You don't do this unless you're being led by the Holy Spirit to do so, but if the Holy Spirit leads you to do that, give it a try. There's power in a touch from God.

It says in **Matthew 9:20**,

*Just then a woman who had been
subject to bleeding for twelve
years came up behind [Jesus]
and touched the edge of his cloak.*

She said to herself, "If I only touch his cloak I will be healed." What faith this woman had, to understand that merely touching Jesus' clothes would instantly heal her. Brothers and sisters, you can do the same thing tonight.

It says in **verse 22**,

Jesus turned and saw her.

*"Take heart, daughter," he said,
"your faith has healed you." And the
woman was healed at that moment.*

Before she made that contact and reached out for Jesus, she had already made the decision in her heart to trust Him. You need to make the decision in your heart that you're ready to receive.

This story is also found in two other gospels, **Luke 8:43** and **Mark 5:25**. These gospels tell the same story, but they all tell it just a little bit different. Yet they all agree that the woman suffered for many

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years and had spent all that she had and still was not healed. Today, there are millions of people on this earth that have spent every dime in search of healing and never found it. That's because, if you don't begin with Jesus, who already healed those who believe, what hope do you have? Nothing can heal the deep, invisible wounds we all live with – except Christ.

It's time to stop relying on ourselves, on our fortunes, on our wisdom, on our strength, on our friends to fix us. People are dying every day from sicknesses and disease. The enemy is robbing us of our health. He's shortening your life. You're meant to live a long life and a healthy life. You don't have to go home sick. That's a lie of the Devil.

I don't want to get sick. I don't want my last days on this earth to be miserable. I want to enjoy life! Jesus died so I could enjoy life and live it more abundantly, and that's the kind of life I want.

What kind of life do *you* want?

The Role of Faith

The woman who touched Jesus' cloak for healing had tremendous faith. Jesus even says it was her faith that healed her!

You have to make up your mind to have faith before you even ask God for something.

Paul said in **Philippians 1:21-22** says,

For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better. But if I live, I can do more fruitful work for Christ. So I really don't know which is better. (NLT)

Paul knew the joy and healing that awaits us in Heaven – yet he says he's not sure which is better, to live or to die. That tells me that God wants us to thrive on this Earth, and not just wait around to die. There is much work to be done for his kingdom.

There is no reason you should have to go home early. You can live the remainder of your days long and healthy. You have a purpose in this life:

Proclaiming and celebrating the love of Christ. As long as you're doing that, you've got a reason to get up every single morning feeling energetic and in in good health.

In **Matthew 9:37**, Jesus is walking with The Twelve:

*Then he said to his disciples,
"The harvest is plentiful but the
workers are few."*

It seems like we hear that from preachers every day: "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers

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the matter.**

are few." See, God needs you here. That's why He has provided healing for you: Not so you could be free from all suffering or hardship. Those times will come. God provides true healing – spiritual and physical – so you can continue doing his work.

If you are sick, you must believe God when He said He wants you well. You have

to accept the truth of God's word when He says that you're already healed. The devil is trying to steal your health by attacking your faith. He's trying to convince you that you don't have a say in the matter, but you always have a say in the matter. Faith gives action to power. There is a role that you play as a *receiver* of God's blessing and healing. I can't do anything more than point it out, but God can do all things for you. The power is up to you to receive it.

Remember that faith comes from hearing God's word, over and over again. Learning to listen and believe the word of God takes time and effort.

Years ago, when I first became a Christian, the Lord convicted me right away of a lot of the stuff I was watching on TV. I dropped a lot of it almost immediately. As I continued my walk with the Lord, He continued to convict me of things so I continued to stop putting them into my mind. I have no interest in those things anymore. I don't even want to see them for a single second.

Lately I got to praying about this. "Lord, we haven't had this talk in a while," I began. There's a few new

TV programs I watch, and I said, “I want you to talk to me, and I want you to let me know again. If I’m watching things that I shouldn’t be watching, I want you to let me know because I don’t want anything robbing me of my faith.” We have to be careful what we feed on in the news and entertainment we consume. Much of it is garbage, filling you up with wrong ideas about God and robbing you of your faith. A few minutes of entertainment is not worth the damage it can do to your faith.

In **Romans 12:3** it says,

Because of the privilege and authority God has given me, I give each of you this warning: Don’t think you are better than you really are.

Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves, measuring yourselves by the faith God has given us. (NLT)

If you’re born-again, you have been given a measure of faith. I didn’t get a bucket of faith and you got a teaspoon of faith. According to the word of God, we all got the same measure, right?

Brothers and sisters, you do have faith! You can’t say, “I don’t have faith to be healed, Pastor Jo.” Yes you do. If you’re a born-again follower of God, you have faith. Now you’ve just got to put some action with it.

Stepping out in Faith

God's word says He directs our steps. The word says that He's got a good plan for you and to do you good and not evil, but give you hope for a good end. He's got all these plans for you and He will provide for you according to his riches and glory.

But how?

God uses humans as instruments to do his will. God uses ministers to deliver his truth to his people. One of these truths is that He does want you well and He has provided healing for you!

Romans 10:13 says,

*For "Everyone who calls on
the name of the Lord will
be saved."(NLT)*

This is what that passage means in the Greek:
*For whosoever shall call upon the name of the
Lord shall be healed, safe from suffering, kept
safe, delivered, rescued, taken out of destruction
and danger and peril, and restored to health.
Hallelujah!*

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There are so many of God's children that are sick and suffering under the hands of Satan, but according to His word, God has made provisions for you to be well.

I realize there are different opinions on whether or not God heals everyone and whether or not that it is God's will to heal everyone. According to what I see in the Bible, the word of God, it is his will to heal and to heal everyone!

If you really want to know what God is like, you need to take a look at the life of Jesus. Do you want to see God at work? Then you look at Jesus. If you want to know the will of God, then you look at Jesus. Jesus is the will of God in action according to **John 6:38:**

*For I have come down from heaven
not to do my will but to do the
will of him who sent me.*

Ask yourself: “Did Jesus go around making people sick?” No!

He went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil. As we read earlier in **Acts 10:38**, God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power, and so He went about doing good and healing all who came to Him. I know that some people are going to say, “God doesn’t do that anymore! I haven’t seen any miraculous healings, Pastor Jo.”

That view simply doesn’t line up with what the Bible says.

God’s word tells you in **Mark 16:17-18**,

“And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.”

If it were God’s will for some of His children to remain sick, Jesus wouldn’t have told us to put our hands on others and heal them as a sign that the Holy Spirit is truly with us.

It is difficult for some people to understand that the darkness and evil we see in the world came into being through the fall of man when Adam sinned and the curse of sin came upon the Earth. Because people don’t understand this, they’ll accuse God of evil things – They’ll accuse God of accidents happening to them and their families. They’ll accuse God of sickness, and they’ll accuse him even of the death of their loved ones; but God is not the author of any of these things. The author of these things is Satan.

Remember: I can’t do anything, but God can. God is working through me and he’s working through you. If you believe the things He says in His word, then you must believe that it is through the words that come out of your mouth that God plans to bring about healing for you and your loved ones.

Jesus said, “In my name they will do these things.” Jesus has personally given us the power and the

authority to use His name. We have permission to use His name against the devil. You don't tell somebody to use their name unless you can trust that person. It's a sign of our authority. When we pray, we pray in the name of the one who's already claimed the victory over sin and death!

Today is the day that you can begin to receive your healing. It might not appear to you how you expected. You might not receive a miraculous, overnight healing of all your pain and illness. But God wants you well, my friend. You don't have to be sick anymore. You can be free.

Today is the day that you can receive freedom from the bondage of the devil. The Lord is here to set us free from all of them. He's able. He's willing.

All that's left for us to do is to believe, and hear the word of the Lord.

Tonight, I command sickness to bow its knee to you, Jesus. I demand every demonic foe to bow before the name of Jesus.

I thank you, God, that you're working through your people to do mighty works. I thank you Lord for the Holy Spirit that is here with me to help me.

Father, I give you all the praise and all the glory in advance for all that you're about to do. I ask you for the courage, wisdom and strength to stand strong and stand on your word in the face of all my adversity.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Pastor Jo accepted Jesus as Lord of her life in June of 1993 in Hampton, Virginia.

She knew immediately that her life would never be the same again.

God called her into the ministry in 1994. After two years of intense study and time with the Lord, she evangelized in some local churches. The Lord placed in her spirit that her calling was to prison and jail ministry.

In 1996, she began her work at the Duplin County jail in Kenansville, North Carolina, and was ordained as a minister in 1997. She visited the jail every Wednesday afternoon, beginning by ministering to the women. After two months, she began ministering to the male inmates every Friday morning, and shortly after this she began seeing both the male and female inmates every Wednesday and Friday.

Her prison ministry grew to more and more correctional facilities until she became the president of the Community Resource Council (CRC) at Duplin Correction center in 1999.

Pastor Jo's first husband passed away in 2002. She was devastated, and buried herself even more in the Word of God and her work.

In 2006, the Lord placed in Pastor Jo's spirit that He wanted her to become the Chaplain of Duplin Correctional Center, despite her lack of formal training. However, she knew from past experiences that if the Lord wanted her there, she would be there. She became Chaplain that very year.

She served as the Chaplain until the Lord brought her together with her soulmate David in June 2009.

Pastor Jo and her husband David both feel that the Lord has brought them together to finish the race as a couple. The Lord has combined their ministries to accomplish the work He has called them to do.

Speak The Word Ministries is the new work God has called them to.

Speak the Word Ministries (STWM) is a ministry anointed by the Holy Spirit with the purpose of teaching and training God's children to become soldiers. The Lord gave her the name of the ministry from Matthew 8:8.

Pastor Jo's platform for accomplishing this is the radio airwaves and the internet world wide, to cover the earth with the Spoken Word of God.
